### Associates

(Level 1,2, & 3)

Associates may play in the following events when all the requirements listed below have been met:

- All Open Championships
- PGA Pro-Am
- Team Events
- Tournament Series Events
- Four Ball
- Pro-Assistant
- Vegas Pro-Am

#### Requirements

- Registered in the PGA PGM 2.0 Program with the National Office
- Maintain acceptable progress in the PGA PGM Program
- Participate in one or more of the following:
  - Attend 2017 Indiana PGA Fall Teaching Summit or 2018 Spring Business Meeting
  - Participate in other National and Section PGA Education in 2018 (6 MSRs Required)
  - CPR/Red Cross Certification Course
  - Attend Indiana PGA Career Night
  - Volunteer for an Indiana Golf Office Sanction Event
- Current on all PGA Dues

### Pre-Associates

(Pre-Qualifier)

Pre-Associates may play in the following events when all the requirements listed below have been met:

- Indiana Open
- Pro-Assistant
- Assistant's Championship +
- Women's State Open
- State Pro-Am's

#### Requirements

- Pre-Associate registration form on file at the Section Office
- Successful completion of the PGA online Qualifying Course (you are considered a Pre-Associate until you have registered for Level 1 of the PGA PGM program)
- Employed at an Indiana golf facility under the direction of a PGA Professional
- Pass the PAT (except for: Indiana Open, Women's Open, and Pro-Assistant)

+ Not eligible to advance to the National Championship

Associates must register for the Assistant's Championship through PGALinks.com or the contacting the National Office

Pre-Associates must register for the Assistant Championship through Bluegolf or call the Section Office
