Founded in 1994, the Indiana Golf Foundation was created to preserve and promote the game of golf in Indiana. The Indiana Junior Golf Program was already well-established, having been formed in 1987, and once moved under the Foundation umbrella, would continue to grow. In 1996, a scholarship program was created to provide financial assistance for students who actively participated in the Indiana Junior Golf Program.

Eligibility and Evaluation Criteria:

To be eligible for an Indiana Golf Foundation Scholarship, all applicants must meet the following requirements: participated in the Indiana Junior Golf Program, excellent academics, strong character, and financial need

- 1. Indiana Junior Golf Program:** Applicants must have participated in the program for a minimum of two years.
- 2. Excellent academics:** Applicants must have above a 3.0 GPA and are required to take the ACT or SAT.
- 3. Strong character:** Applicants must demonstrate a firm knowledge of the characteristics so important in golf; sportsmanship, integrity, perseverance.
- 4. Financial Need:** Applicants who show a need for financial assistance receive additional consideration.

Applicants are evaluated and compete on the above criteria for the three Indiana Golf Foundation Scholarships awarded annually. Each scholarship is a one-time \$2,500 award that can be used toward any college expense.

Application Procedures:

Applications are available on-line beginning January 3rd and are accepted until March 15th of the same calendar year. The student's application, essay and supporting material should be emailed to igf@indianagolf.org. Subject of email should display first and last name and the application name. i.e. Autumn Strong_Indiana Golf Foundation Scholarship. The supporting material should be saved with first and last name and name of the document. i.e. Autumn Strong_Essay
