In 1999, an additional scholarship fund was established at the Indiana Golf Foundation. David E. Simon created a scholarship to reward students who had worked at an Indiana golf facility with financial assistance to pursue a college education.

Eligibility and Evaluation Criteria

To be eligible for a David E. Simon Scholarship, all applicants must meet the following requirements: employed at an Indiana golf facility, excellent academics, demonstrated financial need, and strong character.

1. **Employed at Indiana golf facility:** Applicants must have worked at an Indiana golf facility in the previous 12 months.
2. **Excellent academics:** Applicants must have above a 3.0 GPA and are required to take the ACT or SAT.
3. **Demonstrated Financial Need:** Applicants must show a need for financial assistance.
4. **Strong character:** Applicants must demonstrate a firm knowledge of the characteristics so important in golf; sportsmanship, integrity, perseverance.

Applicants are evaluated and compete on the above criteria for the David E. Simon Scholarships awarded annually. Each scholarship is a one-time \$5,000 award that can be used toward any college expense.

Application Procedures

Applications are available on-line beginning January 2 and are accepted until March 1 of the same calendar year. The student's application and essay should be emailed to clawson@indianagolf.org. The application, essay and all supporting documents (high school evaluation, employer evaluations, transcripts, test scores, recommendation letters and financial information) should be mailed in an unfolded 9 x 12 envelope to: Scholarship Committee, Indiana Golf Foundation, PO Box 516, Franklin, IN 46131
